Charles County is experiencing significant community spread and masks are required in all settings. The mask mandate has never been lifted from healthcare facilities and are still required at all times in Sagepoint and during visitation, even when outdoors.

COVID booster and flu vaccines are currently being issued to residents and healthcare workers.

## **Sagepoint Skilled Nursing Center:**

As of today, we have no known positive cases in staff or residents.

In addition, 100% of Sagepoint's health care workers and 98% of residents in the skilled nursing facility are fully COVID vaccinated.

Skilled Nursing Center Visitors: Due to the colder weather, we will begin scheduled, indoor visitation of residents inside in the Red Room. Visits will be scheduled with Esmerelda Kline (see link below).

Rehabilitation Visitors: Visits will be scheduled in the patient's room. Visitors will be screened at the front door and will use all appropriate PPE including masks. Please use the Front Lobby screen area to complete screening paperwork.

## **Assisted Living and Memory Care**

As of today, we have no known positive cases in staff or residents.

In addition, 100% of Sagepoint's health care workers and 98% of residents in the assisted living facilities are fully COVID vaccinated.
